

Swim to Win prize draw terms and conditions

1. The promoter is: Active Nottingham/Nottingham Swim School whose registered office is at Nottingham City Council, Sport and Leisure, Resident Services, Loxley House, Station Street, Nottingham, NG2 3NG
2. The competition is open to current Nottingham Swim School Junior members. Entrants must reside in the United Kingdom.
3. By entering this competition, the parent/guardian of the entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
4. Route to entry for the prize draw and details of how to enter are via the Swim to Win Activity Cards.
5. Multiple entries will be accepted per person, increasing your chance of winning. Each completed activity card counts as one entry into the prize draw.
6. The closing date for colouring in the activity cards will be close of business, 16 March 2026. After this date, no further 'entries' will be allowed.
7. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
8. The rules of the competition and how to enter are as follows:
 - a. The activity card can be coloured in upon attendance of the following activities
 - i. Swimming lessons – Junior only lessons
 - ii. Public swimming sessions

 - a. Each leisure centre will offer one swimming-themed hamper, with six hampers available in total.
11. The prize is as stated, and no cash or other alternatives will be offered. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability, and we reserve the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
12. Winners will be chosen at random from all entries received and verified by Promoter and or its agents.
13. The winner will be notified by telephone and/or email within 7 days of the closing date. If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within 14 days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.
14. Attendance will be verified solely for the purposes of validating entries. Should entries be deemed to be doctored, the activity card will be rejected.
15. The promoter will notify the winner when and where the prize can be collected from. Delivery is not available.
